It is possible that you may qualify as an exhibitor and not qualify as a demonstrator. **If you're accepted as a demonstrator, you're REQUIRED to educate patrons of your traditional art form(s), method(s) and purpose(s) during all of the shows' advertised hours.**

GENERAL RELEASE AND ACCEPTANCE OF RULES

I / we the applicant(s) have read the "CRAFTER/DEMONSTRATOR GUIDELINES" printed on the booklet attached to this licensing application/contract and agree to abide by said conditions. In addition, I/we, the applicant(s), do expressly release the producer "Appalachian Festival / The Appalachian Community Development Association / all agents acting on behalf of the producer" from any and all liability for any damage, injury or loss to any person or goods or property which may arise from the licensing and occupation of the exhibit space by the applicant(s) and agree to hold and save the Producers harmless from any loss or damage by the reason thereof.

This contract shall be deemed to have been made in the State of Ohio and shall be interpreted in accordance with laws of such state. In the event that legal action is required to enforce this contract or any of the terms thereof, such action shall be brought in the Courts of Hamilton County, Ohio, and the Exhibitor expressly consents the jurisdiction of such courts. The parties agree to accept service of process in such action by ordinary mail sent to their address as set forth in this contract. This contract constitutes the entire agreement between The Appalachian Community Development Association / The Appalachian Festival and the Exhibitor (s), and no modification shall be valid unless in writing and signed by the parties or their representatives.

*I/we understand if this application is **not accepted**, my booth rental fee (minus a \$20.00 processing fee) will be mailed in my **S.A.S.E. with any submitted photographs, on or about April 1, 2022**, provided the producer's received this application by 5 p.m., March 15, 2022. If this application is received after 5 p.m., March 15, 2022, and it's not accepted, my booth fee will be returned as mentioned above, minus the \$20.00 processing fee and the \$50.00 late fee (\$70.00 total.)*

If this application is accepted, I / we give permission to use my name, business name, images submitted, and any photographs or videotape taken at the show of me and/or my staff, or my items for any and all purposes.
