3. The A.C.D.A. will provide no insurance. The Demonstrator agrees to indemnify and hold The A.C.D.A. harmless from any liability or damage to the person or property of the Demonstrator, his/her employees or agents. Day and night security will be provided by Coney Island pursuant to its contract with The A.C.D.A., however, The A.C.D.A. will provide no insurance.
4. The Demonstrator will unload and set up between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Thursday, May 10, 2018. No one is to set up until they see Debi Miner about their assigned space – NO EXCEPTIONS.
5. The Demonstrator will not begin to pack his wares before 6 p.m. on Sunday, May 13, 2018.

ALL WORKERS and MINOR CHILDREN MUST BE DRESSED AND DEMONSTRATING
CAMP LIFE, DURING ALL SHOW HOURS. Additional name badges can be purchased for 10.00 at the
Volunteer Check-In Tent. You and your guest(s) must abide by the Appalachian Festivals' Living History Village Camp Rules, at all times, during the Appalachian Festival.

Vehicles will not be allowed in the park on Sunday evening until the park is officially closed to the public. Please contact Debbie before attempting to bring vehicles into the park.

9. The A.C.D.A. personnel, including those working in the bank, are unpaid volunteers. The Demonstrator agrees to treat The A.C.D.A. volunteers courteously when requesting Festival services. Anyone behaving in a disrespectful manner toward volunteers will be asked to leave the grounds, immediately, and will not be invited back.

The Demonstrator agrees to abide by all regulations presently in this contract, the attached "**Living History Village Camp Rules**" and those that may reasonably be adopted in the future by The A.C.D.A. You and your guest(s) must abide by the Appalachian Festivals' Living History Village Camp Rules, at all times, during the Appalachian Festival.

11. This contract constitutes the entire agreement between The Appalachian Community Development Association / The Appalachian Festival and the Demonstrator, and no modification shall be valid unless in writing and signed by the parties or their representatives.
