Our Mission

To promote the social, educational, and cultural development within the Appalachian Community of the Greater Cincinnati and the Larger Appalachian Region. We strive to improve self image and encourage the best of Appalachian values while creating understanding and appreciation of our cultural heritage.

History

The Appalachian Festival began in 1970 as a project of The Junior League of Cincinnati. Since 1974, the Festival has been under the auspices of The A.C.D.A., a non-profit organization, whose purpose is to promote the educational, cultural, and social well-being of the Appalachian population of Greater Cincinnati. Approximately 34% (or about 300,000 people) claim Appalachian roots in this area, by being 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or even 4th generation Appalachian migrants.

The Purpose of the Appalachian Festival is to provide a marketplace for traditional hand-made Appalachian Crafts; foster among Appalachian migrants in the Greater Cincinnati Area, a sense of pride in their heritage; educate the general public about Appalachian Culture; and, celebrate old-time Appalachian Music, Dance, Stories, Cooking and other cultural treasures. We accomplish this mission by presenting the annual festival(s) and by distributing the revenue from the festival to the small grants program. The small grants are awarded to those educational and/or cultural programs/projects that propose to affirm and enhance the lives of Appalachians and promote pride in the Appalachian Culture.




AUDIENCE

The last two years we have had record-breaking numbers with 15,000 plus patrons visiting the festival over the Mother's Day Weekend.


Male: 39% Female: 61% Combined Tacone: \$70,000



Ethnicity:




Local: 80% Regional: 20%
